

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Employment and Community Studies (EACS) Program is for students with diverse learning needs that hinder educational success.

EACS courses and learning experiences will prepare students for lifelong learning, employment, and community engagement opportunities.

### **PARTICIPATION OPTIONS**

The students in EACS have the option to choose:

- » Which courses they take
- » How they will take courses (part-time or full-time, online or in person, or a combination)
- » To seek a credential or just take a course or two

#### **CREDENTIALS**

Completion of the EACS Program leads to a Citation in Employment and Community Studies at KPU. Credit courses include:

- » Career Exploration
- » Work Experience
- » Introduction to Disability Rights
- » Social Justice in Action

- 2 Participate in an interview with program faculty to determine:
  - Fit for the academic program
  - Satisfactory English ability as assessed according to departmental guidelines
