THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S AWARD


The Duke of Edinburgh's Award program is a direct challenge from Prince Philip to all youth between the ages of 14 to 25. There are one hundred and twenty six countries involved with the Award program.

This program has operated throughout the world since 1956, and in Canada since 1963, and in the British Columbia / Yukon Division since 1969. It offers opportunities to youth for broadening interests and experience under adult guidance and assessment through participation in a balanced program of practical, cultural and adventurous activities chosen to suit individual aptitudes and related to local needs and conditions.

Participation in the Award program represents a personal commitment to constructive endeavour, promoting qualities of self-discipline, self-help and self-reliance.

There are three Awards – Bronze for those over the age 14; Silver for those over 15 and Gold for those over 16. To qualify for an Award a young person must first obtain a Record Book and then satisfy the requirements of the four sections of the program – SERVICE, ADVENTUROUS JOURNEYS, SKILLS AND PHYSICAL RECREATION.

About the Ismaili Centre, Burnaby

Celebrating its 25th Anniversary, The Ismaili Centre, Burnaby is host to this year's The Duke of Edinburgh's Silver Award ceremony.

Designed by architect Bruno Freschi, The Ismaili Centre, Burnaby is one of five Ismaili Centres around the world, soon to be joined by a sixth in Toronto.

The Foundation Ceremony of the Ismaili Centre, Burnaby was performed in 1982 by the Lieutenant-Governor of British Columbia, the Honourable Henry Bell-Irving, in the presence of His Highness the Aga Khan and other distinguished guests. Three years later, in 1985, the Opening Ceremony was performed by Prime Minister Brian Mulroney and His Highness the Aga Khan.

The Ismaili Centres are symbolic markers of the permanent presence and core values of Ismaili communities around the world. Incorporating spaces for social and cultural gatherings, intellectual engagement and reflection, as well as spiritual contemplation, they are bridges of friendship and understanding, and serve to enhance relationships among faith communities, government and civil society.

Since its opening, the Ismaili Centre, Burnaby has hosted a wide range of events, opening its doors to government officials, prominent academics, leaders of many communities, and the wider public.

On a number of occasions, the Ismaili Centre, Burnaby has provided a distinguished venue for the presentation of the Duke of Edinburgh's Award, including the Gold level awards that were presented by His Royal Highness The Duke of York. The events presented award recipients and their families an opportunity to tour the Centre and dialogue with leaders of the Ismaili community.

Most recently, the Right Honourable Michaëlle Jean, Governor General of Canada of the day, led some 200 British Columbian youth in a Truce Dialogue – Canada's expression of the Olympic Truce in the run-up to the Vancouver 2010 Winter Olympic Games. The Centre also recently hosted the Chief Justice of Canada, the Right Honourable Beverly McLaughlin.
