Did You Know?

- The Registered Disability Savings Plan (RDSP) is a Canada-only savings plan designed specifically for people with disabilities and their families.
- If you open an RDSP, depending on your family income, you may be entitled to receive up to \$1000 per year in a Canada Disability Savings Bond (up to a lifetime maximum of \$20,000) without having to make any personal contributions.
- Furthermore, you could receive additional funds from the Canada Disability Savings Grants (up to a lifetime maximum of \$70,000) if you do make contributions. This money will grow tax-deferred and any RDSP withdrawals will not affect any other BC disability benefits available to you or your family member.
