# STEPS TO BECOME AN EEP PARTICIPANT:

#### 1 Contact us

- 2. Meet with us to assess eligibility and employment goals and interests. We will develop independent careers plans and find the Participant work experience
- 3. EEP will send the Participant's resume (with their consent) to Employers or Participants can apply for jobs themselves
- 4. Potential Employers contacts the Participant and/or the EPP Staff to set up an interview
- 5. If successful, the Employer will sign an employment contract with the Participant

#### 6. You're Hired!

- 7. RCD will provide site visits to the workplace and provide any other employment support
- 8. Ongoing evaluation forms will be conducted during and after the 12-week work experience; the Participant may be eligible for a \$300 Completion Bonus

### WHAT EEP OFFERS

- Paid work experience for 30 hours per week for 12 weeks
- Resume and cover letter building
- Custom-built employment support and skills development services
- Individualized career and job search support
- On-the-job support and mentorship
