APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CANADA SUMMER JOBS

RCD hires youth for Summer Camp staff positions through the Canada Summer Jobs initiative, offered through funding from Service Canada's Youth Employment and Skills Strategy.

2020 RCD Summer Project for Youth with Special Needs runs in July and August; employment time starts on June 29 to end of project on August 25, 2020.

To be eligible to participate in the Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ), you must:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act;
- be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations; and
- complete a survey prior to the end of the work placement.

Successful candidates will be hired as an employee of the RCD, subject to all BC Employment Standards requirements:

- Income tax, CPP and EI will be deducted from each pay check as appropriate
- 4% vacation pay, in lieu of vacation time, will be added to each pay check as appropriate
- Statutory holiday pay will be in effect according to the BC Employment Standards
- RCD will cover the BC WorkSafe premium coverage
- Weekly salary pay will be in effect; time sheet needs to be submitted for wage payment
