Once a child becomes an adult at age 19, parents no longer have the legal authority to make decisions on their behalf. A Representation Agreement is a legal document for personal planning in British Columbia. It is a way to authorize your personal supporters to help you manage your affairs or make decisions on your behalf if you need assistance due to illness, injury or disability. This workshop will introduce families to what the Representation Agreement is, where they can find helpful resources online, and how to help their adult family member complete an agreement.
