EXTERNAL GOVERNMENT BENEFITS

We're here to help you find the right resource for your needs.

Persons with Disabilities Designation



A provincial program that provides eligible people with disabilities financial assistance and access to supports.

Canada Pension Plan Disability



A federal program that provides financial support for eligible individuals whose disability prevents them from working.

Disability Tax Credit



A federal tax credit that reduces income tax for eligible people with disabilities or their supporting family members.

Registered Disability Savings Plan



A long-term savings plan that helps people with disabilities build financial security with government contributions.



Recreation Fee Subsidy Program



A program that reduces the cost of recreation, fitness and community programs for eligible individuals and families.

BC Housing + Affordable Housing



A provincial program that provides affordable housing options and support for eligible individuals and families.

HandyDART + HandyCard + Taxi Saver + BC Bus Pass



Multiple provincial programs that provide accessible transportation options, discounted fares, and mobility supports for eligible individuals with disabilities.
