Our Services

Our Independent Living (IL) Program empowers individuals with disabilities to live independently and engage in their communities through four core pillars that foster personal growth, connection, and inclusion.

Information & Networking

- Access reliable information, referrals, resources, and networking opportunities related to disability, accessibility, and community services

Skills Development

- Develop practical life, employment, and self-advocacy skills through educational programs

Recreation & Peer Support

- Connect with others through inclusive recreational activities and peer support programs

Community Engagement

- RCD's outreach team networks in the community with other agencies, organizations and businesses

Accessible Parking Permit (APP)

- Apply for an APP through RCD
- Complete the application with your physician signature
- Submit your completed form to RCD with the required processing fee (\$33)
- Receive your permit by mail or pickup
